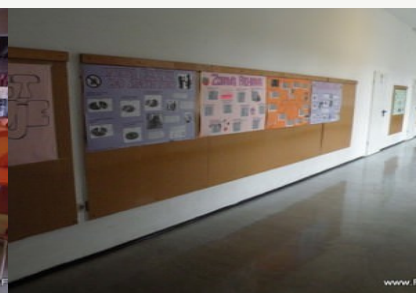

The agenda of the meeting:

22 May Sunday:

All the partners arrived in Koper and settled in the hotel.

23 May Monday:

Partners met at the host school for the opening ceremony in the morning.

After a short walk around the school guided by the students, some ice - breaking activities were held for students. Two workshops, plastic and eco challenges, were run by the host school.

Before lunch at students' hall of residence, we went on a tour of Koper.

In the afternoon, we visited the Town Hall and had a meeting on energy issues with the town authorities. Last but not least, a beach volleyball competition took place at Beach Volley Park Koper at the end of the day.

24 May Tuesday:

After breakfast we left for a daily trip to Ljubljana. On our way first we visited to Postojna cave carved by the Pivka River over millions of years. After a guided tour in this unique place in the world, we arrived in Ljubljana and discovered the green areas of the capital. One of the most important spots in the city was a cyanometer, an instrument for measuring "blueness" specifically the colour intensity of blue sky.

At the end of the day we got on the bus to go back to the hotel in Koper.

25 May Wednesday:

We gathered at the host school in the morning for the presentation on Energy policies in Koper.

It was presented by Andrej Hrabar, senior consultant for energy management in City Municipality of Koper. After that, videos on How to save electricity? prepared by each partner country were watched. And then, we visited to Port of Koper and learned its environmental policies during this guided visit.

In the afternoon, to have our lunch and for a short tour in Piran, we departed from Koper to Piran which is a town in southwestern Slovenia on the Gulf of Piran on the Adriatic Sea.

26 May Thursday:

After breakfast, very early in the morning we left the hotel in order to visit to the museum of coal in Velenje. Velenje mine is a lignite mine which is owned and operated by government. In the afternoon, we went to Celje, the fourth-largest city in Slovenia.

After having lunch and some free time in Celje, we visited Tehnopark Celje and participated in some workshops done by technopark employees.

27 May Friday:

In the morning, we met at school to see students' presentations (from each partner school) about the statistics and use of energy sources in different countries. After that, while teachers were having the project meeting, students had the evaluation session in international groups using Wakelet. After lunch, there was a certification and official closing ceremony of the meeting at school. And also, a very nice Erasmus cake cutting ceremony was held with good wishes.

In the evening, official farewell dinner, attended only by teachers, was held in a restaurant. Students were hosted by the Slovenian students at the last supper.

28 May Saturday:

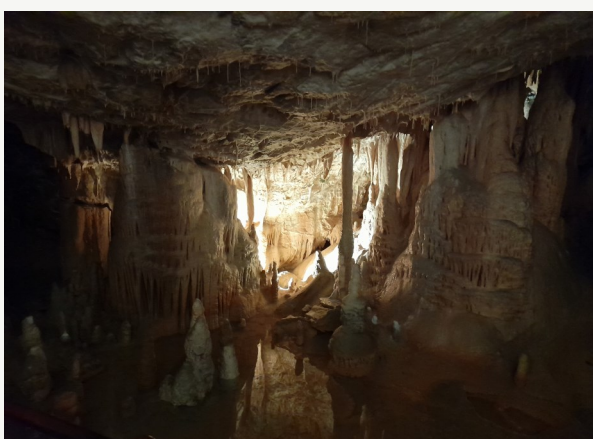
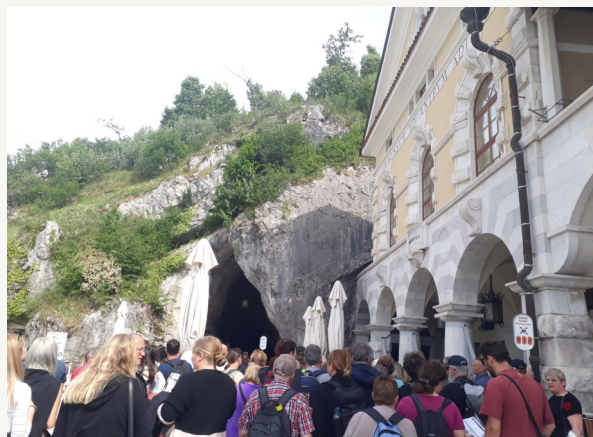
Partners departed from Koper for their countries.
